Nacogdoches Mission Guadalupe Rededication

“Celebrating 300 years of Christianity in Texas”

In 1716, the first Spanish settlers came to East Texas bringing with them 12 Franciscan priests. This was a historic occasion for the Catholic Church as it was the beginning of our church in Texas which has been here continuously for 300 years. On July 9 in Festival Park near downtown Nacogdoches at 9:00 a.m., a historical Mass will be held along the banks of the Banita Creek by Monsignor James E. Young. Afterwards there will be a short reenactment ceremony depicting the events of the dedication of the Mission Nuestra Senora de Guadalupe on July 9, 1716.
