We received bids on the following projects, and while we may not be able to complete everything on the list, the painting, flooring and gutters (immediate needs) will be done before the Fall 2016 semester.

The painting, confessional and sacristy have been completed. The gutters are scheduled to be replaced July 28, and the flooring should be completed before August 15.
